2021 WVC Annual Conference Dates Moved from February to September

After receiving survey results, Viticus Group decides to reschedule the next WVC Annual Conference to September 6-9, 2021.

LAS VEGAS, NEVADA (August 12, 2020)—Viticus Group is happy to announce the new dates for the 2021 Dr. Jon R. Pennell WVC 93rd Annual Conference: Monday, September 6—Thursday, September 9.

The organization based its decision on survey feedback from the veterinary community in which most felt that an autumn date for the WVC Annual Conference would provide more time to adjust to post-pandemic circumstances (vaccine distribution, travel safety, etc.) and be more convenient for their schedule.

Other advantages of holding the conference in September rather than February include avoiding flu season and the destination opportunities of Las Vegas during that time of year such as exceptional weather and lower travel costs.

Viticus Group is also adding a virtual component to the 2021 conference, making it their first hybrid event. More details will be provided in future months.

"Of course safety is a significant concern when planning for a large conference, but hearing the preferences of the participants themselves through the survey was the key factor in our decision to move

back the dates," says Andrea Davis, CEO at Viticus Group. "We're making the adjustments that are best for veterinary professionals under the circumstances, and we look forward to having another amazing WVC Annual Conference next fall."

The WVC Annual Conference will then return to its regular schedule and welcome everyone back to the Mandalay Bay Convention Center and Viticus Center campuses on March 6-9, 2022.
