With more 25 years in the field, Dr. Stewart has become a national advocate for animal welfare, access to care, and the human–animal bond. His work through Project Street Vet, providing free veterinary care to pets of the unhoused, earned him the title 2023 CNN Hero of the Year and global recognition for compassionate leadership.

WVC Vegas 2027 is four days and 850-plus hours of continuing education, an exhibit hall featuring approximately 600 exhibitors at Mandalay Bay Convention Center, several hands-on lab trainings (additional purchase required) at its Vegas purpose-built education center, Vegas-style entertainment and much more. Conference participants include mostly veterinarians, as well as
