If approved, you will receive further instructions for booth selection.

How do I make a payment on my booth?

To make a payment, you must access the Exhibitor Service Center for the event you are participating in. You should have received a login and password from eShow once your booth was approved. If you cannot find the login and password, please contact the Exhibits Team at exhibits@viticusgroup.org.

What are the exclusive services for WVC Vegas

The following is a list of exclusive services for Mandalay Bay.

- Food and Beverage – No outside food or beverage (F&B) may be brought in or distributed to participants. ALL (F&B) must be ordered through Mandalay Bay Exhibitor Services (MBES). If you have a unique request, it must be approved by MBES. Please note that if approved, you will still be responsible for any corkage or usage fees assigned by MB.
- Electrical for the booths – Power **is not included** with your booth. If you require power, it must be ordered through MBES and Edlen Electric. See the service kit for pricing and information.
- Network/internet – MB provides only minimal bandwidth throughout the convention center. If you need additional bandwidth, it must be ordered through MBES.

Is flooring required for our booth?

Yes, all exhibitors are required to have flooring for their booths. Our rule is that no concrete should be visible in the booth. You have two options. First, you can order flooring from our Contractor Fern. Second, you can bring your own flooring. We allow your own carpet or foam squares. Please ensure this is professional. Lying down a blanket does not qualify as flooring. If flooring is not placed in the booth, carpet will be required at the Exhibitor's expense.

Can we bring in our own materials?

Yes, you can hand-carry components from the designated parking lot in a suitcase or self-rolling case. You are not permitted to use dollies, hand trucks, or power conveyances to move the items.

Is a certificate of liability insurance required?

Yes, all exhibitors must submit a valid certificate of liability insurance 30 days prior to moving into the exhibit hall. Exhibitors may submit their own certificate or purchase coverage through WVC. Please note that any exhibitor who has not submitted their certificate 30 days before move-in will be charged the WVC coverage fee. No, we will not accept a self-provided certificate within the 30-day period. If your renewal falls within the 30-day time frame, you will be required to purchase WVC coverage. In addition, you are required to pay the coverage fee before you will be allowed to move in.

Can Minor access the show floor?

No one under 18 years of age may access the Exhibit Hall during setup and teardown periods. This is a safety and liability issue; no exceptions. If anyone under 18 is seen on the floor during these designated times, they will be escorted from the floor, and the exhibitor may be removed from participation. During the Exhibit Hall's posted open hours, there are no age limits for access to the Hall.

Are costumed mascots allowed?

Yes, WVC allows a costumed mascot. However, the mascot **must remain within the purchased booth space only!** The mascot is not allowed to engage with participants outside the purchased space. This includes exhibit hall aisles, lobby space outside the exhibit hall, and the education hallways/sessions.
